POLICY ON USE OF LANGUAGE DICTIONARY

1.1 Use of Dictionary

1.1.1 Any applicant writing the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society's bar examination who has French¹ as their first language, may be permitted to bring to the exam a clean copy of a French¹/English dictionary.

Permission to be Obtained in Advance

1.1.2 Permission must be obtained in advance of exam sitting from the Director of Admissions and Professional Development.

¹ For ease of drafting, this Policy refers specifically to French/English, but applies equally to any applicant whose first language is not English, and who requires the use of an English translation dictionary.
