BAR EXAMINATION

POLICY - WRITING AT A LOCATION OUTSIDE HALIFAX

1.1 Location Outside of Halifax Permitted

1.1.1 Applicants may write the Bar Examination at a location outside Halifax.

Application Requirements

1.1.2 At least four weeks prior to the examination date, applicants who desire this option must apply in writing to the Director of Admissions and Professional Development.

Writing Outside of Halifax, but within Nova Scotia

1.1.3 Applicants desiring to write the Bar Examination at a Nova Scotia location outside Halifax must arrange to write at the office of a member of the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society who is not a member of their firm.

Writing Outside of Nova Scotia

1.1.4 Applicants desiring to write the Bar Examination in their province of residence must contact the Law Society of which they are currently a member and make arrangements to have their examinations invigilated by the appropriate staff or designate of their Law Society.

Same Rules and Procedures Apply

1.1.5 All examinations are subject to the rules and procedures of the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society, whether written in Halifax or at another location.

Fee for Non-designated Site

1.1.6 The fee for writing at a location other than the designated examination site is set by Regulation.

Invigilation

1.1.7 The Society's *Policy on Invigilation of the Bar Examination* applies.
