1.1.2 The Society tests the legal knowledge of applicants by way of the Nova Scotia Bar Examination. Knowledge of the substantive law in the following subject areas will help prepare students to write the examination and to practice in Nova Scotia:

- (a) Administrative Law
- (b) Business Organizations
- (c) Civil Procedure
- (d) Commercial Transactions
- (e) Constitutional Law
- (f) Contracts
- (g) Criminal Law
- (h) Evidence
- (i) Ethics/Professional Responsibility
- (j) Family Law
- (k) Real Estate/Advanced Property Law
- (l) Torts
- (m) Wills and Probate.
