

These fees are in effect for the Society's Fiscal year May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2012. In the event of any discrepancy between this fee schedule and the Society's Regulations, the latter shall prevail.

4.7.2 In circumstances when the amounts due under subregulation 4.7.1 are payable other than on July 1, the amounts, as prescribed in subregulation 4.7.1, can be paid on a prorated monthly basis in full or by a preauthorized withdrawal schedule.

4.7.3 If a preauthorized withdrawal pursuant to subregulations (4.7.1)(a)(ii) and (4.7.1)(b)(ii) is incapable of being honoured for any reason, including insufficient funds in the member's account, the following consequences shall apply:

- (a) the member is deemed suspended in accordance with subregulation 4.6.1 and the provisions of subregulations 4.6.1 to 4.6.8 apply; and
for purposes of subregulation 4.6.6., all appropriate fees will be the remainder of the fees then due to the Society and a reinstatement fee prescribed by subregulation 51.

4.7.4 The net amount payable pursuant to subregulation (4.7.1) (b) is subject to a surcharge if in the period after May 1, 2000, a claim payment was made by the Association on behalf of the member, which surcharge is calculated on each paid claim in the twelve month period from May 1 to the next April 30 as follows: 40 percent of the assessment, prescribed by subregulation (4.7.1) (b) (i), for each of the five years following the date of the claim payment.

4.7.4.1 The net amount payable pursuant to subregulation 4.7.1 (a) is subject to a surcharge of **10 percent of the assessment** prescribed by subregulation 4.7.1(a) if the member has not met the requirements of subregulation 8.3.2.2 by April 30, 2009.

4.7.4.2 The net amount payable pursuant to subregulation 4.7.1 (a) is subject to a surcharge of **20 percent of the assessment** prescribed by subregulation 4.7.1(a) if the member has not met the requirements of subregulation 8.3.2.3 by April 30, 2009.

4.7.4.3 The surcharge referred to in subregulation 4.7.4.1 and subregulation 4.7.4.2 shall be applied annually until the member meets the requirements of subregulation 8.3.2.2 and, if required, subregulation 8.3.2.3.
