Please consider this my response to the request from the NSBS for public input regarding Trinity Western University's application to open a law school in British Columbia.

I cannot on any level condone such treatment of any person. Years ago admission to school could have been refused because of the color of your skin. This was wrong then and is wrong now. I see this requirement to sign the community covenant as no different.

Anyone that holds the idea that discrimination is acceptable and is willing to sign a covenant affirming their position should not be welcome to practice law as a member of the NSBS. It is only right that the NSBS make their position clear so anyone signing the covenant would know that as a result they would not be called to the bar in NS.
