BAR EXAMINATION: POLICY ON USE OF LANGUAGE DICTIONARY

1.1 Use of Dictionary

1.1.1 Any applicant writing the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society's bar examination who has French¹ as their first language, may be permitted to bring to the exam a clean hard copy of a French¹/English dictionary.

Permission to be Obtained in Advance

1.1.2 Permission must be obtained in advance of exam sitting from the Director of Education & Credentials.

Inspection of Dictionary

1.1.3 Upon arrival at the examination, the applicant must present the dictionary to his or her invigilator for inspection.
