The Complaints Investigation Committee of the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society gives notice it has imposed practice conditions and restrictions on the practicing certificate of Darren Morgan of Sydney, Nova Scotia, pursuant to Section 37(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*.

The conditions and restrictions include the following:

- Darren Morgan will respond to all communications from clients and from the Society, either directly or through staff, within a reasonable period of time, normally within two business days.
- With the exception of retainers pertaining to drafting estate planning documents, or consultations or retainers arising from Legal Assistance Programs (so long as these do not involve court appearances), or residential real estate transactions, Darren Morgan will not take on any new files, unless otherwise authorized by the Society.
- Darren Morgan will not take on any articled clerks or students.
- Darren Morgan agrees to have a Practice Supervisor acceptable to and paid for by the Society to do the following:
 - I. Conduct an initial meeting with Darren Morgan as soon as possible: to review his open files, review his court/client meetings schedule, understand how his practice is organized and the systems he has in place to manage his practice.
 - II. Thereafter meet with Darren Morgan regularly, at a frequency as determined necessary by the Practice Supervisor, to ensure that he is managing his practice in a manner consistent with this Resolution, and that he is meeting his ongoing commitments to clients and the Society.
 - III. The Practice Supervisor shall provide regular reports to the Society.

These conditions and restrictions will remain in place until further notice.
