LIANS March Report

Articling Survey Results

The Education & Credentials and Equity & Access departments – working in collaboration with the Western Canada Law Societies – conducted two surveys in 2024 to better understand current issues associated with the articling experience and the training of new lawyers. The Final Report arising from these reflects key findings in relation to two themes: preparedness for practice, and experience of discrimination and harassment during articling and/or recruitment.

Jennifer Pink and Marla Brown presented recommendations to Council based on the survey results.

Finance Budget Discussion 2025/2026
